In Partnership with the [Roddenberry Foundation](#), we are bringing Digital Financial Inclusion to the SCOA members in remote rural areas of Uganda. 61% of our beneficiaries have so far been onboarded onto our mobile digital platform. With this development, members can access information on their saving and apply for loans using their mobile phones wherever they are.

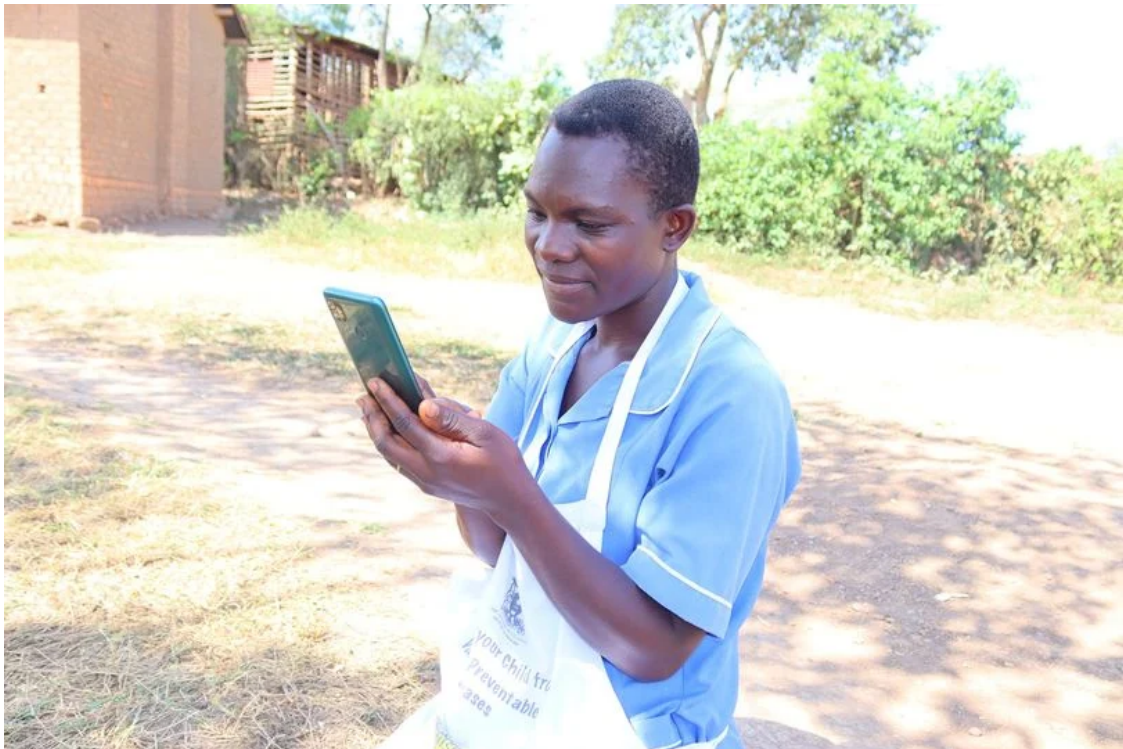

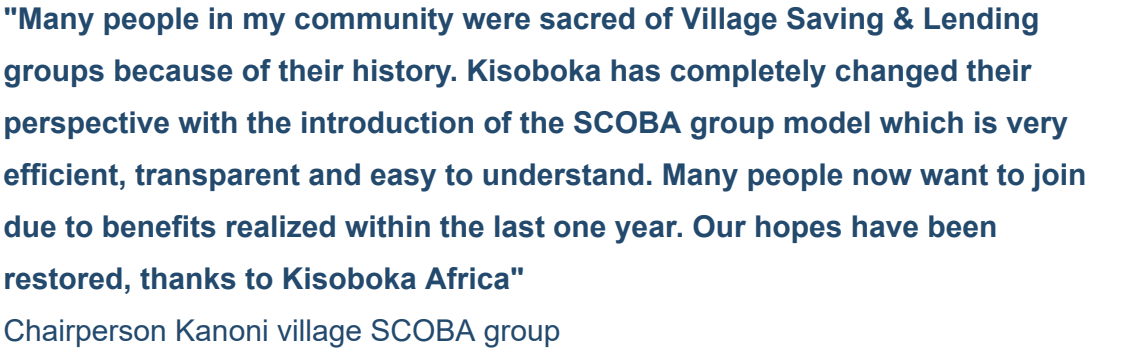
